The role is responsible for leading, developing, and organizing all facets and elements associated with each worship environment, including team development, resource allocation, and short/long range planning. All members of the Weekend Experience team report to this role.

This is a full-time, salaried position. Compensation is based on experience and includes an extended benefits and vacation package. Working hours may require working evenings and weekends.

Primary Responsibilities:

Department Head and Direction Team Involvement

- As part of the Department Head and Direction Teams, provides insights, direction, and vision implementation for the church, particularly how it relates to the Worship Environments.
- Works closely with the Lead Pastor so that the Mission, Vision, and Values are carried out within the Weekend Experience team and liturgy.

Weekend Experience Team Oversight

- Oversees the staff and SERVE teams who are responsible for liturgy creation, planning, and execution.
- Works closely with the entire weekend experience team to maintain uniformity in feel.
- Manages the staff who oversee the necessary scheduling, reserving, and resourcing worship team members and contracted musicians for their assigned environments/services.
- Maintains an on-platform presence during weekend services (on average 2 out of 4 Sundays) and major events.
- Planning, development and leading of various special services, such as but not limited to Christmas, Palm Sunday, and Easter.
- Oversee the coaching and preparation of all speaking roles during services, to include but not limited to the Hosting role.
- Oversee staff who are part of Tech and Production.
- Manage all related budgets.
- Create the processes and structures so all necessary staff and SERVE team members are able to speak into creative elements for all worship environments.
- Recruit, train and encourage volunteer SERVE teams who help with various tasks and projects.

Worship Ministry Development

- Develop healthy relationships and rhythms with the members of the Worship Experience staff so they are growing and thriving in their roles.
- Recruit and develop vocalists and musicians for use in all worship capacities.
- Empower staff and volunteers to accomplish the following:
 - Prepare recordings and charts when needed for all worship environments.
 - Recruit and retain guest worship leaders and musicians.
 - Develop special musical groups and arrangements, which includes rehearsals and song selections.

- Maintain resources for Worship Ministries, such as but not limited to managing green room supplies or Spotify playlists.
- Other duties as assigned.
